As of December 2, 2013 Bradley completely converted our wetted components for the specified product lines to lead free compliant. On January 4, 2014, the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act takes effect. This act requires plumbing parts that touch water and are anticipated to be used for human consumption must have less than or equal to 0.25% weighted average in lead content.

With this transition, Bradley products, including service parts and kits, will be compliant with the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act of having less than or equal to 0.25% weighted average in lead content, with some exceptions. The exceptions include products that will be exempt from this requirement. Exempt products include the Showers product line, Emergency Fixture product line, toilets, urinals, hose boxes, and the related service parts for those products.
