

CHALLENGE

The Cheyenne Mountain Zoo in Colorado Springs, Colorado is America's mountain zoo, perched at an elevation of 6,714 feet (2,046 m) above sea level. Ranked the 6th best zoo in North America by USA Today in 2019, the zoo is home to animals from all over the globe.

To support its mission to provide guests unforgettable experiences 365 days per year, the zoo has been renovating many of its existing buildings and constructing a number of exciting new exhibits. There are hands-on opportunities involving animals, such as hand-feeding the zoo's large herd of giraffes.

With thousands of patrons daily feeding and petting animals, eating messy foods like melting ice cream cones and using the restrooms, the zoo's hand washing fixtures serve an important function in keeping hands clean and germ-free. Moreover, the sinks must help keep the newly remodeled restrooms clean and well-maintained, attractive and inviting, and easy to access and use for all ages.

SOLUTION

The design team at Cheyenne Mountain Zoo evaluated several hand washing systems for the busy public restrooms near the zoo's main entrance and Bradley's Verge® with WashBar® quickly rose to the top of their list. "The WashBar fixture is streamlined and much more intuitive to use than the other models," a zoo design team member said. "The other units we considered have individual dispensers that create a clunky and cluttered appearance on the deck. I also noticed they leave soap splotches in the basin.
